<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q1. @David_Helene Our education, background, and experiences make us who we are. Please tell us about the non-resume you? We want to know what's not on your resume. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @CollegeFutures <u>@David_Helene</u> I was born/raised in Brooklyn, which exposed me to diff communities & experiences from a young age (I still live in Brooklyn bc #whereBrooklynat). Both parents were teachers, who left edu to start small businesses, so edu & entrepreneurship were valued @ #EquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> I had the #RealPrivilege of being able to focus only on my studies at college & never had to worry about my basic needs. But my Dad was a #RealCollege student at Hunter, though at a time when tuition was ~0. He was able to go to college bc policy made it possible. #EquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> I've internalized that my own experience was a gift made possible bc policy made it so for my dad. And I've been hell bent on making sure we create like policy that makes college completion realistic for other #RealCollege students like my dad bc justice requires it. #EquityChat

<u>@David_Helene</u> As you and @SDMesaPrez know well, emergency aid is an absolutely essential modern tool to address #RealCollege students' basic needs. @edquityapp helps institutions deliver it equitably and easily, maximizing enrollment, retention, & graduation. #EquityChat

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> .@sdmesacollege is #allin. We can't wait to maximize our partnership and support our students in meaningful, efficient, effective and real ways!

<u>@David Helene</u> Based on the research of our CSO @saragoldrickrab (), our approach treats students with dignity. No one has to perform their poverty to get help. Students who need help are taken seriously & given support fast. And funds get to students who can benefit the most. #EquityChat

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> We launched our app yesterday and ... wow! All I can say is Thank You for having dignity as a core value as we support our students during these unprecedented times!
<u>@David Helene</u> Traditional emergency aid is fraught with administrative burden and bias. Colleges lose money, students lose time -- and their prospects for persisting. We're proving there's a better way that reduces stress for everyone, students and staff. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> Processing a single application can take 2-10 hours of college staff time. That's a lot! We handle the end to end process: application, decisioning, distribution, compliance reporting. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez



<u>@David Helene</u> Our platform relieves these burdens, so college staff & faculty can focus on the student-centered work of advising/teaching. The pandemic is stressful for everyone, & we know students aren't the only ones facing basic needs insecurity. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> Most important, Edquity treats an emergency like an emergency. We receive and process applications and distribute funds all in the same day, 24/7. Students can't afford to wait, so we waste no time. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@LaurenMcgowan</u> The @unitedwaykc team thinks that taking @edquityapp to scale is key to increasing persistence & completion for #RealCollege students. We must trust students when they have a financial emergency and trust that with \$ they can resolve that emergency. @edquityapp does that & more

<u>@PencilearsArt</u> my experience with edquity is there is no way to tell them what you need.they decide what you are going to get based on your demographic information. you cannot say "I need this much to pay my rent" you cannot show them a bill you need help with, you get what you get.

<u>@PencilearsArt</u> in addition their app is help together with twine and bailing wire, it is designed to skim the information from your banking habits and you don't bank with a bank who will allow them to do this, the service does not function.

<u>@PencilearsArt</u> they are a poor replacement for a functioning financial aid department, and a poor replacement for 2k backdated monthly pandemic releif checks from the government.

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q3. @David_Helene How does the @edquityapp approach promote racial equity? #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @CollegeFutures @edquityapp

<u>@David_Helene</u> This may be the single most important issue we focus on @edquityapp #EquityChat <u>@David_Helene</u> Structural racism pervades typical emergency aid design, w/ a focus on "deservingness" & other microaggressions. Applications often make students jump through hoops and wait days, even weeks, for help. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> Often, student need is assessed in ways that allow for implicit bias or given out on a "first-come, first-served" basis that advantages white students & those with family wealth. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez <u>@David Helene</u> Other programs assess need using FAFSA EFC, which neglects core causes of racial wealth inequality such as debt, which again, disadvantage minoritized students. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez <u>@David Helene</u> Our approach works the opposite way. We are universally accessible, understandable, and caring. We use a decisioning framework that focuses most on objective conditions more often experienced by BIPOC students. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez https://t.co/llplPtkyCR

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> It is! We dipped our toes in for our initial roll out and plan to completely submerge ourselves moving forward. Ripples will be made and felt by our students!



<u>@David Helene</u> We also use lessons from public health to deal w/ resource scarcity & avoid first-come, first-served funding, prioritizing using objective criteria. And we review the data to assess our actual impact to continuously refine our approach. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@weeepam</u> Serving large public institutions atm? How many EAID cases are they seeing? We serve 55k students & (lengthy)applications aren't slowing down at all. How do we best handle this kind of VOLUME in a TIMELY manner while being hyper sensitive to who's applying / who's not & why.

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> Q4.@David_Helene. Many @CalCommColleges have begun to receive the HEERF II. What advice would you give to higher education and @CalCommColleges leaders as they prepare to spend the HEERF II funds? @edquityapp #EquityChat @SDMesaPrez @lamkeithcurry

<u>@David Helene</u> Recognize that this is a major opp for innovation & systems change, and a chance to move to more aspirational practices away from the same old thing. It's also a chance to prove to the feds and states that emergency aid is a critical and effective tool they must fund. #EquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> HEERF II thankfully offers greater flexibility than CARES. Students don't have to be T4 eligible (at least based on language we've seen), and they don't even have to be currently enrolled in some cases. Awards can also be made for anything w/in COA. #EquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> That said, a big change is institutions must prioritize students w/ "exceptional need", which means that the rationale for funding & ability to represent the methodology for determining need may be scrutinized more. @edquityapp makes that easy. #EquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> My advice to leaders: make the process easy for students, prioritize equity in decision making, and make it fast -- but NOT first-come, first-served. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q5. @David_Helene Why is emergency aid to students so essential, and what evidence do you have that supports @edquityapp has been working? #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @CollegeFutures <u>@David Helene</u> Unconditional cash transfers are clearly effective anti-poverty tools all over the world. Cash is king when it comes to addressing basic needs flexibly and with dignity. Yet another study was covered just today on this topic. #EquityChat https://t.co/ofDwdvBcPF

<u>@David Helene</u> As you know, we have the in @saragoldrickrab to ensure our work is grounded in ongoing research and to ensure we understand our ongoing impact. #EquityChat





<u>@David Helene</u> @Hope4College found that during the first wave of federal emergency aid (CARES), it took colleges on average 13 days to turn money around to students, which is devastatingly long. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> Meanwhile, we've helped students go from application to claiming funds in on average 25 hours and 87% of students we've served have reported that the grant has helped their likelihood of persisting. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> We are proud to be serving 30+ colleges (w/ serious love to @compton_college, our first CA partner, & @sdmesacollege) & have processed over 30,000 applications & distributed over \$13MM in the last 7 mos. \$2.5MM of that came in the last mo. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> We have data from our partners indicating that we've served a proportion of minoritized students that are disproportionate relative to the demographics of the overall student population. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> Most importantly, we'll be releasing research shortly showing that during the pandemic we've doubled graduation rates among students we've served at one of our earliest partners, one that both of you know quite well. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> Those early results ! But also the election, and trends in more enlightened policy. I'm heartened to see emergency aid continue to be included in the stimulus packages, and to see a third stimulus likely coming. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@David Helene</u> And with the above in mind, we need to see sustained emergency aid for students & bills like @SenTinaSmith's proposed Oct bill that would provide YoY federal funding for EA passed. States also need to do more to provide sustained appropriations for annual EA. #EquityChat <u>@David Helene</u> And last: everytime I'm in a room (Zoom?) with leaders like @lamkeithcurry, @SDMesaPrez, @LoweryHart, @ChancellorMay I have hope. We have transformative leaders fighting their so out for students. It's hard not to have hope when you see the intensity of that fight. #EdquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> It's also good to see states like California respond to #EquityAvengers and continue to lead the way on state-based #RealCollege policy, with Governor Newsom including \$100MM in emergency aid to CCs this year. #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q7. @David_Helene What are you reading? And what book(s) would you recommend we consider reading? #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry

<u>@David Helene</u> We've actually put together a reading list that has inspired our work and speaks to issues like scarcity, administrative burden, the importance of cash transfer, and impacts of policy on #RealCollege students that I'd highly recommend. #EquityChat https://t.co/VaBxPNjtmb

<u>@David Helene</u> I also think a lot about leadership, which I know you and @lamkeithcurry do too. The Advantage by Patrick Lencioni has been tremendously helpful as I think about culture building and broader organizational health, and applies to all sort of leadership environments. #EquityChat

<u>@David Helene</u> Finally, Automating Inequality by Virginia Eubanks, for someone who runs an antipoverty tech co., is a key reminder that tech is no panacea. Books like that motivate us @edquityapp & reinforce the need for our practice of building w/ the communities we serve. #EquityChat
