<u>opomonacollege</u> Dr. Curry, so glad to "see" you. Equity means focusing on unlocking human potential. It means removing barriers, and lifting up with support where it's most needed. It means we all have basic needs that have to be met before we can excel. 1/2

<u>@pomonacollege</u> Pomona is a liberal arts college. We look demographically very much like America, after an intentional process of recruitment and support. Graduation rates aren't determined by demographics. 1/5

<u>@pomonacollege</u> We are about 12% international and about 26% first generation or low wealth. All of our financial aid is grant—no loans. 55% of students receive aid, and last year we distributed \$51.5MM in student aid. We are majority minority. 2/5

<u>@pomonacollege</u> Pomona has chosen to emphasize that excellence in education means an equal commitment by our institution to every student we can reach. 3/5

<u>@pomonacollege</u> My job is to help find the resources for us to fulfill the mission of sending compassionate, talented students out into the world with the full equipment to succeed and to bring others up with them. 4/5 <u>@pomonacollege</u> I think building partnerships with different kinds of institutions, like Pomona and Compton College, will build a more equitable future, because we all will bring to the table new ideas and new passions. 5/5



<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> @compton_college and @pomonacollege teams have been meeting to create a unique partnership centered around students. Special thanks to @Lande_Ajose @MonicaCLozano for putting Dr. Starr and @lamkeithcurry on a taskforce together.

<u>@pomonacollege</u> I think this is a natural partnership. We are in the heart of Los Angeles, and are pulling together for the future of California.

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> Q4. Dr. Starr, @pomonacollege . How have @pomonacollege adjusted due to COVID-19? Post COVID-19, how can @pomonacollege improve to serve the most vulnerable student population? #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez @CollegeFutures

<u>@pomonacollege</u> We pivoted to fully remote on March 13, 2020. We are fortunate to have significant financial resources. We dipped into our reserves and spent funds to get technology to every student (a computer and an internet hub) around the world who needed it. 1/4

<u>@pomonacollege</u> We increased financial aid to cover funds students might have been able to earn by working in a normal year. 2/4

<u>@pomonacollege</u> We raised money to send instruments to our music students, samples to our geologists, reagents to our chemists, materials to our artists. 3/4

<u>@pomonacollege</u> Now we have to get L.A. County students back on campus, so that everyone has a stable place to learn. That's key to equity. @LACountyBOS

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q5. How has @pomonacollege engaged in anti-racism work? How do you engage and prioritize the student voice @pomonacollege in anti-racism work? #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez @CollegeFutures <u>@pomonacollege</u> By dismantling some of the racist assumptions that can haunt learning. For example, some physics classes begin with ancient Greeks, as if no culture beyond the Mediterranean ever discovered anything about the stars, fluid dynamics, light, or matter. 1/3

<u>@pomonacollege</u> @pomonacollege professors work with students to explore discoveries made in the ancient worlds of Central America, the Great Plains, Africa & the Middle East. This helps students understand physics & discovery are in the reach of all human beings, not just some. 2/3

<u>@pomonacollege</u> We also believe it is important that students have a voice in departments (in hiring faculty, for example), in designing student experiences so that they are meaningful for everyone, & in helping identify the legacies of racism we see so we can work together to solve them. 3/3

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> Q6. Dr. Starr, @pomonacollege .What three recommendations would you provided to the Biden Administration about the challenges higher education institutions are faced with at this time? @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez #EquityChat @CollegeFutures

<u>@pomonacollege</u> And because I need one more—don't penalize private institutions that do the things that state institutions can't, but enable us to spend the funds we have raised for financial aid and student success freely. 4/4
<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> I'd love to dig in to this one a little more..

<u>@pomonacollege</u> As part of tax reform, Congress passed a tax on institutions with large ratios of endowment per student. That hits institutions like Pomona right at the heart of what we do. <u>@pomonacollege</u> We were proud to spend \$51.5MM on grant financial aid to students this year; and not to package loans. it could have been nearly 2MM more. @ACEducation @aiccucal

<u>@pomonacollege</u> It has to begin in K-12. The assessment industry serves primarily to continue to preserve the need for assessment. Give teachers and schools the ability to make site-based choices to best serve the needs of their students. One size will never fit all. 4



openmonacollege Enhance regionally focused public institutions so that they can serve the students who need it most—colleges know our back yards. Enhance opportunities for transfer from 2- to 4-year colleges. 2/4
oppomonacollege Support students through increased, interest-free, funding for basic needs--nutrition, shelter, technology, textbooks, dependent care—so that they can pursue their educations first. 3/4
