<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Our Question 1 tonight for you @saragoldrickrab is What is your definition of equity, how is equity-minded practice embedded in your work? #EquityChat @lamkeithcurry #RealCollege

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Q1: Equity-minded practice is embedded in all of my work with @hope4college and @edquityapp and @BelieveStudents - in every organization we recognize students as humans first and aim to meet those basic needs.

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Follow-up ...can you recall the first time you identified #RealCollege work within the lens of #Equity?

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Definitely. I was a graduate student and attended an AACC convention— my first time with a lot of community college leaders. This had to be around 2001. It was in Seattle.

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> I was sitting in a talk by a prominent cis-gendered white man, who was describing data on students who attended multiple colleges. He wondered aloud "why would they do that?"

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> He showed us transcripts where students bounced from community college to community college and four year to two year and said, something is wrong here... I'm thinking "yeah...."

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Q1: Data is also key to equity-minded practice because it can help check our implicit biases. Of course, data can also be biased— I learned about this early in my training from Ruth Wallace and @TukufuZuberi <u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Q1: In my view #equity is about trying to understand and give people what they need, to enjoy healthy lives. I'm drawing on Sandeep Kumar's writing here, which really appeals to me. #EquityChat #RealCollege

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> I love the simplicity and possibilities of this definition. #EquityChat <u>@lamkeithcurry</u> Q2. @saragoldrickrab. Many of us are involved with you in the #RealCollege movement with

@Hope4College. What advice can you provide for practitioners engaged in the real college work? #EquityChat @SDMesaPrez @lamkeithcurry

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> - Beware of the "streetlight" effect when it comes to listening to experts— they know only what they consider important

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Ok-that was a lightbulb [light bulb] moment for me...implicit bias is everywhere....

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Think about all those years we were told "the answers are in the toolbox." Remember that report? Well the answers can't be in the toolbox if you never asked the questions!

@sdmesathestand Or if you don't have a toolbox... [face with rolling eyes]

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> Got it! Such info should be used to expand our capacity - the real experts are our students! We should be listening to them! #EquityChat



<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Yup. I'm here because of the student who told my team "I haven't eaten for two days." That was 2008.

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> I am here because of @compton_college students and faculty. @SDMesaPrez @saragoldrickrab #EquityChat

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> - Listen to students, while also attending to the structural inequalities shaping what they can tell you - Connect. This work is so isolating!

<u>@STLGraduates</u> Thank you for pointing out how important relationships are in this work! <u>@lamkeithcurry</u> Most leaders don't recognize how important relationship are to our organizations. #EquityChat

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> Relationships are EVERYTHING! I believe @Fharris3 and <u>@DrLukeWood</u> said that there is "No Learning Without Caring" - its impossible to care without establishing relationships. #EquityChat

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> They are! We created the #RealCollege conference because of the profound isolation people feel in this work. The whole point was to get in one place and be together. That's how I met @rubenecanedo @AEDukehighered @RachelSumekh @RashidaCrutch and so many others for the first time

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> The last conference was amazing, it was refreshing to be at a conference where you don't have to explain how important this work is. #EquityChat @SDMesaPrez @lamkeithcurry @saragoldrickrab

<u>@STLGraduates</u> We have to create the space for the coalition of the willing.

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Q2: - Be brave. We are pushing again long-held assumptions and "truths." - Walk and chew gum at the same time- work on basic needs programs at multiple levels. Structural and individual.

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> This is a summary of the report and its findings. This should make all of higher ed PAUSE.





In March 2020, the coronavirus pandemic struck American higher education. Colleges closed campuses, students lost jobs, and emergency resources failed to meet the demands caused by the crisis. This report examines the pandemic's impact on students, from their basic needs security to their well-being, as indicated by employment status, academic engagement, and mental health. While the survey response rate was 6.7%, it nevertheless represents an uncommonly large multi-institutional student sample; perhaps the largest thus-

far during the pandemic. The timing of the survey—fielded from April 20 to May 15, during the uncertain early days of the pandemic – likely contributed to the response rate. Participating in the survey also required internet access and provided limited incentives to students.

The survey assessed food insecurity over the prior 30 days, and housing insecurity and homelessness at the time the survey was completed.







PANDEMIC



<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> What to do re CARES? Well, first, y'all in CA are very lucky to have <u>@EloyOakley</u> - he just made a huge difference with that lawsuit! Opening access to non-Title IV students is a must.

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Speed matters. Focus on need matters. @lamkeithcurry is using @edquityapp to help with his #emergency #aid right now— any thoughts on that?

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> @edquityapp worked for @compton_college students. Listening to @compton_college students who received funds talk about how easy the process was amazing. I think @compton_college was the first @CalCommColleges to participate in @edquityapp @SDMesaPrez @saragoldrickrab

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> I mean, every #equity minded president has to ask: How long does it take from the time the student starts our application to the time they receive the support? The right answer? Less than one day. On a 24/7 clock. <u>@edquity</u> does it in a half a day [fire] <u>@saragoldrickrab</u> And by the way, anyone can give out money - but to do it with an evidence-based model focused on equity and Justice??? That's ROI.

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> @saragoldrickrab. Food insecurity during COVID-19 is real. I am a firm that colleges have to deliver food to student homes during remote learning.

<u>@AdrianaMaestas</u> I know that @PCCLancer Pantry had drive through service for awhile during spring semester. Home delivery would be nice for students who have transportation services, but would that be hard to staff?



<u>@ahandsintheair</u>. @sdmesacollege is also hosting drive through Mobile Markets. Home delivery sounds amazing. @lamkeithcurry, I'd love to learn more about how you do that.

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> Partnership with @foreverytable and @Grubhub. We worked with the @FoundationCCC on a statewide contract with @Grubhub

<u>@sdmesathestand</u> This topic came up in a meeting today. How can we leverage our current resources to get food to our students. [red heart]

<u>@saragoldrickrab</u> Please focus FIRST on SNAP for all and grocery cards. Give people as much dignity and choice and flexibility as possible.

<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> I don't disagree but getting @compton_college to sign up have been a struggle.

@sdmesathestand Here as well. But we keep trying!
