<u>@carmelnikki</u> A4. I think one barrier is knowing when to ask for help and who to turn to, especially when you may be the first in your family to go to college. With that, also a feeling of whether or not they belong in the higher ed space. (1/3) @lamkeithcurry @SDMesaPrez #EquityChat

<u>@carmelnikki</u> A4. That's why it's important to have a diverse faculty & staff, especially one that represents the students you serve. Seeing people like them teaching and leading on campus can help students feel more comfortable reaching out and feeling like they belong. (2/3) #EquityChat

<u>@carmelnikki</u> A4. I also feel that sometimes accessing resources for support can be difficult to navigate. There's often a lot of legalease that's hard to understand, or too many administrative steps to access the help needed. Simplify processes & make them easy to find (3/3) #EquityChat
