<u>@TCCpres</u> The simple example I like to use is. Every one of our students needs to be provided with shoes, but the type of shoe, size, fit, etc. must be different. One size does not fit all and shouldn't when we are working to provide critical supports for students. #equitychat

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> I like this example-also some of our students need shoes....and access to them is thwarted by poverty

<u>@TCCpres</u> Exactly. Sometimes we forget that we have so many students on our campuses who are arriving every day not having access to the basic necessities that we all know we need is human beings. And it is our responsibility to do whatever we can to address that. #equitychat

<u>@ahandsintheair</u> [footprints] [high-heeled shoe] [thong sandal] [woman's sandal] [woman's flat shoe] [man's shoe] [athletic shoe] [ballet shoes] [hiking boot] Equity sees individual students, with individual needs and pays attention to detail by providing them with the size, fit and style for success to happen. #EquityChat

<u>@TCCpres</u> I define equity as providing people with support and resources they specifically need to achieve whatever goals they may be working towards. Those supports may be different for each person, but what is important is an attempt to provide a "level playing" field. @equitychat

<u>@TCCpres</u> At TCC we are working to embed an equity-lens in everything we do. We have some ways to go to fully realize this, but we are making great strides. We want to develop an institution that provides an environment for every student to succeeed no matter who they. #equitychat

<u>@TCCpres</u> Well TCC does not only stand for Tacoma Community College, it also means The Comminity's College! TCC is part of the fabric of the Tacoma-Pierce County. We are a place committed to creating an environment where every student, faculty, staff, community feels valued. #equitychat

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q3. @TCCpres -How has @tacomacc adjusted due to COVID-19? Post COVID-19, how can @tacomacc improve to serve the most vulnerable student population?

<u>@TCCpres</u> We worked to provide faculty and staff with needed technology, quickly created operating procedures, changed needed policies, developed strong communication plans, and stayed in close communication with our local health department. #equitychat

@SDMesaPrez What lessons learned will you keep even as we recover? #EquityChat

<u>@TCCpres</u> One thing we have to continue to work on is how to train students to use needed technology remotely, when many don't have experience with the technology they are supposed to be using to even ask for help. We are starting to do small on campus group trainings. #equitychat

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Great work-we could do more on this @MarkManasse @AndyMacNeill <u>@ahandsintheair</u> At @sdmesacollege we were just discussing tech support (not just during business hours) & trainings for students. We are seeking ways to let them know that providing technology is only one part of our partnership, making sure they know how to use it is the other. #EquityChat

<u>@TCCpres</u> Wow, where do I begin? First, we are in WA were the first case appeared in the US. Because of this we were part of the first way of institutions to decide to move all instruction and college operations to run remotely. #equitychat <u>@ahandsintheair</u> That is indeed a WOW experience. I appreciate that TCC did not just react but responded ....with an equity lens. That's when you know an institution gets it. There are many ways you could have responded (esp absent any models.) I appreciate that equity was your "go to"!

<u>@TCCpres</u> What I am most proud of is through all of our planning, discussions and actions, equity was in the center. We focused heavily on how to provide our most vulnerable students with the resources we know they would need to assist them complete their education. #equitychat

<u>@TCCpres</u> This support for students included ensuring students could request for from the food pantry online and schedule a time to pick it up. We created online access to emergency funds, provided over 500 laptops for students to keep and other needed tech. #equitychat

<u>@TCCpres</u> Our equity lens even drive decisions such as only allowing asynchronous online instruction, because we wanted to provide every student the flexibility to address their personal/family needs while also continuing their education. #equitychat

<u>@TCCpres</u> We adjust grading policies, payments policies, and the list goes on. Although we were dealing with a pandemic, I was super proud of the work the faculty and staff did to support all students, particularly those who are most vulnerable. #equitychat

<u>@TCCpres</u> We also created avenues for students to utilize needed services like tutoring and counseling. #equitychat
