<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> I did indeed-breaking down all those old walls!

<u>@drkastout</u> We also ask our colleges to define equity for their work so that there is a common definition and understanding on their campus. Looking at data, disaggregating the data, and understanding the whole student experience is part of that work. #EquityChat

@SDMesaPrez How do you ensure colleges look at racial equity? #EquityChat


<u>@drkastout</u> We expect our colleges to center Racial Equity in their work, to lead with looking at the Black student experience and then to explore the intersectionalities of other data and the experiences of BIPOC students and other marginalized groups.

<u>@BViniair</u> Just reread The Plague by Camus. There is a section where he talks about how inequity was intensified and "exacerbated the sense of injustice rankling in men's hearts."



<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> I agree. The problem that exists at many colleges is finding time to have conversations about data and equity. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> At @AchieveTheDream we have a statement on equity that we expect all colleges in our network to champion. Part of that statement lives on everything in the organization.



<u>@drkastout</u> But we need to move past disaggregation to understand it to break down the power structures on our campuses that present barriers to student success. And we try to empower faculty to take action in the classroom by sharing the data. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> We were founded in 2004 with helping colleges to build stronger and more equitable student success outcomes. Equity was centered in the organization's mission from the beginning for students of color and low income students. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> Now 16 years later, we have led the way across not just #comm_colleges but all of #highered in understanding that access only will not build our local communities or lead to economic and social mobility for our students. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> COVID has exposed the deep vulnerabilities of our students, vulnerabilities that we know exist about from the data but now can see in powerful ways. And our entire college community sees those vulnerabilities. #equitychat <u>@drkastout</u> Faculty have responded with amazing speed and innovation. Our staffs have somehow stood up universal remote services. We moved our food pantries and technology support centers into parking lots. Our parking lots became WiFi hot spots. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> We dismantled some of those structures I talked about earlier, in a day without debate, because we had to. That includes moving to practices like self-guided placement or multiple measures & stopping placement tests. #EquityChat




<u>@drkastout</u> These are practices that don't take the whole student into account and are practices we have studied for years, piloted around for more years, and with COVID moved forward. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> And let's not forget the emergency aid programs we developed and the new ways the community has stepped up to help students stay in school. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> I think our #comm_colleges have stepped up to this crisis in ways that really show the strength of our sector and demonstrate the value of the localness of our colleges. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> The big question, right? First, we need changes in federal, state and institutional policy and those changes need to be aligned and not fighting against one another. #EquityCha



<u>@lamkeithcurry</u> I read this comment over and over again. My response [microphone] drop. #EquityChat <u>@drkastout</u> Next, those changes must be tied, at every one of those levels to funding, system design, and practices. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> For funding we should look at funding that goes to students and institutions. The CARES Act tried that approach and it was not designed in an equitable way to support the students #Comm_colleges serve. #EquityChat <u>@drkastout</u> Local funding has been tied for too long in too many places to the tax base of an area and that perpetuates the structural underfunding of some #comm_colleges, similar to k-12 education. #EquityChat <u>@drkastout</u> Systems redesign would bring new transfer policies into the forefront of our policy priorities. <u>#EquityChat @drkastout</u> And institutional practice would require us to develop policies inside our colleges that support advising systems, the design of culturally responsive teaching practices, etc. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> I feel really bad that I did not know about @Drlbram's book, Stamped, until recently especially since it is award winning. I heard @pgccpres interview him on Monday evening. Amazing conversation. You can catch that on You Tube. #EquityChat

<u>@drkastout</u> Another book I would suggest that I finished a few months ago is Heartland by Sarah Smarsh. It is a memoir that really hit home for me. #EquityChat
