We cannot afford to a generation of students who drop out because of the pandemic and their concerns about money.#equitychat

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Indeed, and we need a broad strategy for all kinds of students...parents, part time, etc <u>@M LGarcia</u> SEARS Survey was issued fall 2019. Before COVID, students were struggling to make ends meet. In any given month, 1 out of 3 students experience food and/or housing insecurities. In the wake of the pandemic, 70% of students have lost some or all their income. #equitychat
