<u>@CAELnews</u> I'll flip this a bit and note a silver lining: the pandemic has forced us to reassess how to meet learners where they are, e.g. online classes and other flexibility. But shutdowns have decreased hands-on learning opportunities, and a lack of child care has forced tough choices.

True to its name, the IDN furthers this goal through inclusive workforce and economic development strategies to reach underserved adults.
