I am named after my grandmom, who was a tobacco sharecropper in North Carolina, I stopped out of college three times, that includes once in graduate school, and I experienced poverty in adulthood even after obtaining my two degrees. #EquityChat

<u>@EAB</u> (1/2) For me the definition is simple, equity is providing individuals what they need at any given time across everchanging life circumstances. I am continually asking who benefits from this body of work? Who doesn't? #EquityChat <u>@EAB</u> (2/2) That's where disaggregation of data comes into play to uncover hidden gaps. In my work at EAB, I gravitate toward practices and reforms that address structural racism around advising, student support, mental health, and belongingness. #EquityChat

<u>@EAB</u> College leaders also have to clearly define what equity is on their campuses. Far too often it's left up to interpretation and we cannot reform our institutions without clear definitions and without leaders willing and ready to take on the work.
