<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> 1)As a first-gen, immigrant, my parents came to the US for a better life, to fulfill their dreams & aspirations for their children. This lived experience shaped my understanding of the impact of a college education particularly as a means to economic mobility. 1/3 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> 2)I am the product of the CA community college system (CCC) and have a genuine commitment to the mission of the CCC. This has shaped my passion about this work. 2/3 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> 3)My college journey was shaped as an EOPS student at Fullerton College. EOPS staff believed in my potential to succeed long before I realized it for myself. This experience inspired me to pursue higher ed in order to make a difference within educational spaces. 3/3 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> Equity is eliminating disparities in student success measures & meeting students where they are. It entails intentionality in sustaining a socially-just evolved set of college structures & culturally relevant practices to ensure students achieve their educational goals. 1/4

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> It is embracing the fundamental belief that all students can succeed, &, as educators, place the onus on us to redesign our learning environments to ensure every student's experience is designed for success. 2/4 #EquityChat <u>@MyIrvineValley</u> I model & embrace the belief that all students can succeed, & I directly & indirectly contribute to a culture where student-centered learning predominates. We have a responsibility to address & eliminate academic & social barriers, 3/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> & work with campus stakeholders to create solutions & effective strategies. It requires a paradigm shift within our higher ed structures not created for many of the students we serve today, nor which included ed leaders from backgrounds such as mine. 4/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> IVC is a dynamic institution with a diverse student population. We are an Asian American Native American Pacific Islander Serving Institution (AANAPISI); and an emerging Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI). IVC is committed to student equity, access, & success. 1/5 #EquityChat

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> Our students outperform the CA average on several success metrics. 66% have degree or transfer as their ed goal. IVC has a strong transfer culture, reflected in our high transfer rates. 59% of students work and attend classes & 42% of students receive fin aid. 2/5 #EquityChat



<u>@MylrvineValley</u> Onboarding as president during the pandemic presented several challenges while also creating opportunities to create a sense of community within a virtual platform. 3/5 #EquityChat

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> I embraced the community's expectation to be intentional in building trust & caring relationships across the college; be visibly present, transparent & fully engaged; fostering collaboration; & by providing leadership as an active participant in our college's equity journey. 4/5

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> My role as president is multi-dimensional. I am often the "face" of the college to our local community. I am a facilitator, problem-solver, consensus builder, & student advocate. 5/5 #EquityChat

<u>@SDMesaPrez</u> Q4 @MyIrvineValley. What are some creative ways @MyIrvineValley has utilized relief efforts/funds to support students, faculty, and administrators during the pandemic? @SDMesaPrez @CollegeFutures #EquityChat <u>@MyIrvineValley</u> IVC invested state & federal funds in the following major areas: direct student emergency grants & food assistance; equipment (i.e. laptops) for students and employees to support remote learning & operations; 1/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> meal distribution & health services drive-thrus; hotspots, software support, personal protective equipment (PPE), cleaning and sanitization supplies, COVID-19 tests, & other critical purchases to combat the coronavirus. 2/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> To transition to remote learning, we implemented a learning management system that could deliver lab classes, such as biology, physics, & dance. Another web-based learning management system that allows courses to be delivered virtually was also purchased. 3/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> Most recently we dedicated resources for student re-engagement, focusing on students who stopped out during the pandemic. Targeted activities include a Call Center, debt discharge, & completion incentives for students who are 2-4 classes short of completing their program. 4/4

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> Embracing my intersectionality as a Latino, gay, cisgender male has allowed me to be a more authentic leader although it wasn't always so. Often there is a presumption that I am straight, & I recognize this bestows heterosexual privilege. 1/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> As a young professional who was selectively "out," my race & ethnic identity was, for many years, prominent. Through the years, I learned to fully embrace my intersectionality & navigate my career as an LGBTQIA+ leader in a predominantly heteronormative world. 2/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> Speaking your truth & bringing your lived experience as LGBTQIA+ leaders provide an understanding of the experiences of marginalized students. It allows us to navigate multiple communities, provides a unique understanding of power & privilege 3/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> ...and in building inclusive coalitions to dismantle structures that have often left us without a place or voice at the table. Be bold and be unapologetically you! 4/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> Students' ability to access online ed during the pandemic & how faculty incorporated virtual teaching modalities demands a dialogue on the future of distance ed (DE). We have an opportunity to redefine what we will look like in a post-pandemic world 1/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> ...and to retain "best practices" related to online learning, instructional, & student support. It is my hope and expectation that we NOT hit the "reset" button to teaching, student support modalities, or remote work that mirrored what we had in place before the pandemic. 2/4

<u>@MylrvineValley</u> Student demand coupled with instructional expectations requires dedicated dialogue & planning to articulate a vision for the future of remote learning and work. 3/4 #EquityChat

<u>@MyIrvineValley</u> This should include a needs assessment, development of a comprehensive vision, & the design of an infrastructure that can support student demand & needs, instructional design, faculty expectations, professional development, & staffing considerations. 4/4 #EquityChat
