So many different points that catalyzed my journey. The first point is when I met my research partner and close friend - @fharris3 from San Diego State. We served as research partners and still do. The second is when we started the Minority Male Community College Collaborative (M2C3) and started doing work on College Men of Color. That work brought us to the White House and to other key venues. The third is during the pandemic when we started doing mega-webinars (5K-20K) focused on equity-minded teaching and learning and counseling in the online environment. The fourth is when we started doing work on the term, Racelighting. Racelighting is what happens when gaslighting is racial. Become transfer ready institutions. I'm informed by the work of scholars such as Dimpal Jain and Caroline Turner who have noted that we have to create institutions that are DESIGNED to serve and receive transfer students. Turner says it "takes two to transfer" and Jain says we must create a "transfer receptive culture." Questions to ask: 1). do you have a transfer first year experience? 2). do you have a transfer center that supports their transition into the four-year institution? 3). what have you done to improve articulation? 4). do you have programs designed to serve students who are older, have dependents, and are independent?
