(2/4) If we want every student to get the education they deserve, decades of research shows we need to reach them where they're at - emotionally, experientially, and more. Historically, we've failed to do that along pretty stark racial and other demographic lines <u>#EquityChat</u>

(2/4) The community has grown significantly over years, both in size & depth of r understanding & exploration. Open ed is a practice & openness is a mindset, so I hope 2 see community moving towards that broader perspective. The mechanisms: tech, licenses, can follow <u>#EquityChat</u>

(3/4) I really see <u>#OER</u> moving towards the digital public goods realm, embedded into larger issues facing education, student success, dual enrollment, global challenges. So OER becomes more of a means to an end, not just OER for the sake of OER <u>#EquityChat</u>

(4/4) At the end of the day, this comes back to good teaching practice: inclusive pedagogy, relevant content, student co-creation of material. We're just trying to do it in a more equitable way by developing that content as a digital public good from the jump. <u>#EquityChat</u>

(1/4) It's important to think of OER as part of wrap-around services for students, such as supporting student's basic needs, greater digital equity, improving the quality of teaching and learning overall. As a trustee, I see OER's benefits across a variety of areas <u>#EquityChat</u>

(2/4) We have to make sure that other trustees, who are looking at their enrollment numbers, understand the number of students who drop out, do poorly, or don't choose to pursue certain majors because the materials and textbooks are simply too expensive <u>#EquityChat</u>

(3/4) Leveraging OER to replace expensive textbooks won't fix food insecurity among college students, but we've heard time and time again that those few hundred dollars can be a meal on the table or not. And need to look across all pathways, ZTC, GenEd, CTE, transfer <u>#EquityChat</u>

(4/4) Trustees also need to be advocates for faculty, and look at how commercial vendors may be infringing on their academic freedom, compromising student privacy, etc. <u>#EquityChat</u>

(1/4) It's incredibly important 4 educators 2 remember that there is always more learning for us to seek out. Curiosity is so important: whether it's weighing "what (or who) is missing from this conversation?" or "did this accomplish what we intended? why? why not?" <u>#EquityChat</u>

(2/4) We place tremendous value in listening to our partners and to practitioners on the ground. We've set up structures to bring in a range of perspectives, and to explore how we can better serve the field. This requires a ton of intentionality, but it's so worth it <u>#EquityChat</u>
