(1/5) I can think back to a time at a previous institution where our data clearly showed that the student group that needed the most support was students who looked like me, particularly Black men.

(2/5) I developed a plan to develop a program to support Black male students, and initially received pushback from the college. Understanding the importance of this work, and having experienced many of the challenges while I was in college that these men were experiencing

(3/5) I found a way to move the work forward. Fast forward and the program became successful and the college then "embraced" it fully. That experience helped me realize that for me to have the most ability to move forward with meaningful change...



(1/6) Yes, I was definitely surprised by some of the findings, both good and not so good. Starting with the not so good, I was surprised that only 1 in 4 students who were accepted into the program were able to lease up. This was a result of multiple challenges.

(2/6) In particular students had a difficult time completing the complicated HUD application and many experienced challenges finding landlords who would rent to them. This mirrors the experiences many people from low-income backgrounds have when using housing vouchers.

It really does and is so frustrating how these barriers continue to exist.



(3/6) On a positive note, I was surprised and pleased with the outcomes. The program had a positive impact on graduation rates, with housed students having higher rates than the national average.

(1/7) There are lots of takeaways from the work and study that we hope will provide valuable information to other higher education institutions as they work to address issues of student housing insecurity. Some of the key takeaways are:

(2/7) Implementing a program like this is heavily dependent on adequate funding, staffing and support.

Dr. Ivan Harrell @TCCpres

(3/7) There is a need to have staff supporting the students who have more of a social work background as opposed to a "traditional" student affairs background. Many of the students come with issues, concerns, and needs that require intensive support.

(4/7) The source of funding is important. Because this program relied upon federal funding, through HUD housing vouchers, we were limited on how to use the funding and it required substantial bureaucracy that may not be needed if we were able to use college or private funding.

It's important for us to elevate these issues—people think we have sources to support low-income communities but then are frustrated by outcomes. The level of bureaucracy is real on both sides.
