(1/3) It may sound simple, but I believe access to postsecondary education is the breakthrough we are all (still) looking for. It is right in front of us. We know that completing a degree or credential is a pathway out of poverty.

(2/3) We also know that minority students have less access to higher education. Access means giving students the tools to get to and through college. That means financial aid policies and affordability, but it also means preparedness and career exploration.
