This BSI designation addresses a direct need in California. This bill effectively recognizes the commitment of California colleges and universities that are making significant investments in ending historic disparities for Black students. (1/4)

This designation will be similar to the existing federal recognition of HSIs and AANAPISIs and allows institutions to set a high bar for schools and showcase their focus on Black students. (2/4)

These designations require a certain percentage of enrollment come from those respective groups. Predominantly Black Institutions (PBIs) require at least 40% Black identifying students (3/4)

...meaning they essentially follow the location patterns of HBCUs & very few institutions in the West could ever be recognized for serving Black students.#EquityChat (4/4)

The issues this new designation is designed to address are not new for Black students. Affordability, academic support, student services, finding belonging on campus – these are all things that HBCUs provide to Black students. (1/3)

There are four major areas in this legislation that will address community engagement.

1) It will increase access to educational resources for Black students. (1/4)

This is such an important component that is often overlooked. <u>@CalCommColleges</u> educates the most significant number of Black-identified students but gets funded \$13,378 per FTES versus \$22K for CSU and nearly \$35K for UC.

2) it incentivizes institutions to be more engaged in their community outreach and support. 3) The requirement for co-curricular opportunities, affinity centers, and African American studies programs can create a supportive campus environment. (2/4)

We know that underserved areas often lack diverse cultural representations and see this as an opportunity to make a significant difference in helping students feel included and motivated to succeed. (3/4)

BSIs are a step in a long pathway of support that starts in early childhood. BSIs must collaborate with local K-12 districts. These institutions must find meaningful connections with local industry that will lead to good paying jobs for Black Californians. (1/3)

I thought I knew a lot about our state's and our nation's history, but as our task force researched the history and harms of chattel slavery, my eyes were opened even more. Even though CA entered the Union as a free state, it was a free state in name only. #EquityChat (2/4)

California acted like the Southern slave states. We had a fugitive slave law to capture and return people who had escaped their bondage. If you were a slave and gave birth to a child, that child was considered a slave. CA's first Governor even owned slaves. #EquityChat (3/4)
