We use data to guide policy & check it against the students/college experiences. Recently, we released 3 reports w/ CA's statewide student assoc.'s to highlight college affordability at UC, CSU, +CCCs. We found that costs far exceed tuition, including non-tuition expenses. $\frac{1}{3}$

Even w/ aid, students turn to work, loans, or reduce enrollment to cover costs + low-income & BIPOC students are more likely to incur debt. We collaborate with equity groups, researchers, parents, students, & civil rights orgs to advocate for policy changes & investments. 2/3
