So often the expectations are lower, and the belief that the students will achieve is dismal in underfunded schools. However, when you develop a full understanding of the population you serve, albeit underfunded, you come to understand the brilliance that is found there, and often, much greater resilience and determination to achieve. Eliminate systems that prevent certain groups from accessing resources, opportunities, or fair treatment. The zip code in which a school is located, should not be the determining factor for the above stated. That is, however, not the case. The areas with the greatest need lack resources. Students and teachers are not given the same opportunities as their counterparts in other zip codes. #EquityChat

Educational barriers in low-income areas – whew! Where do we begin? Inadequate funding leading to limited resources, understaffed schools with less experienced teachers, lack of access to advanced coursework, high student-to-teacher ratios, unstable home environments, and limited access to support services to name a few - all of which can hinder their academic achievement. Educators and leaders can help level the playing field by advocating for equitable funding, providing targeted support programs, recruiting and retaining high-quality teachers, creating enriching learning environments, and collaborating with community organizations to address students' needs outside of school. <u>#EquityChat</u>

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Moving students academically, who had always been below basic. I did this by putting in the hours outside the normal school day to tutor, and by finding creative ways/methods to teach below level students to achieve growth. Including parents as important stakeholders. I worked hard to build meaningful and productive relationships at the start



of the school year and remained consistent with them. Building confidence and self-esteem in students who had lost hope. I recognized their strengths and celebrated their success, no matter how small, using positive affirmations daily. <u>#EquityChat</u>
